BERLINER WEISSE 10

We have decided to go a step further and allow you to choose between the amazing liqueurs from Giffard that we have on hand. We recommend Fraise du Bois <<wild alpine strawberry>> or Apricot. It's not just for girls! Think of it as breakfast beer.

PALOMA 10

Milagro reposado tequila, San Pellegrino Pompelmo, and fresh lime juice.

BELLINI 10

*The Venetian classic made with Canella Prosecco and true Italian white peaches.
Made with no added sugar or preservatives.*

FRONT PORCH 10

Absolute vodka, Fresh mint, and lime juice muddled together and topped with Pomegranate juice and club soda.

ANGEL OF ALBA 10

Angel's Envy port aged bourbon, Boroli Barolo Chinato and chocolate mole bitters. Served up.

SICILIAN NEGRONI 10

Bombay Sapphire, Campari and Amaro Averna with orange bitters over ice.

JAMESTOWN SNAP 10

Bombay gin and lemon juice topped with pinot noir and served on the rocks.
